## Dear Congressman Beyer:

On behalf of the managers and supervisors currently serving our nation in the federal government and whose interests are represented by the Federal Managers Association (FMA), we extend our deepest thanks to you for introducing legislation (H.R. 4827) that would provide back pay to federal employees furloughed during a government shutdown.

Federal employees are dedicated to supporting their fellow Americans and their communities. As you know, given the uncertainties and potential lapse in funding, many employees anticipate a furlough of an undetermined length. As a result, many employees would be unable to meet their congressionally-mandated missions, and would also struggle to meet personal financial demands.
