## *A Note from Steve*

### *Year-long patriotic observances planned for nation's 250th festivities: It will feel like July 4<sup>th</sup> during a historical year for the Navy and NNSY*

Looking ahead, the Year 2026 will be a big one for the United States when it observes its 250<sup>th</sup> birthday. I got a head start recently when I visited the American Revolution War Museum in Yorktown, Virginia. More about this local historical jewel in a minute.

But I'd also like to help the nation celebrate our beginnings in Colonial Philadelphia that also holds a special place for me; I grew up a couple of miles from Independence Hall, Betsy Ross' House and a lot of other related landmarks, including Benjamin Franklin's burial site.

**Back to Yorktown's museum:** Located near its popular beachfront, the American Revolution War Museum features a wealth of displays and exhibits with easy-to-read copy blocks, eye-catching photos, nostalgic items of that period and many hands-on interactive offerings.

Before I talk about various displays, let me mention that this place has one of the largest and diversified gift shops I've ever seen at a museum. Visitors should be able to find something he or she likes—from Patrick Henry socks to a very large collection of books about the American Revolution.

Chesapeake residents will be glad the successful Battle of Great Bridge is explained in a descriptive display. You'll recall the colonists fought the mighty British army early in our Revolution—prior to the founding of America—with the foreign power having more than 100 killed or wounded, while the colonists suffered one person injured.

Gun enthusiasts will relate to arms of the Revolutionary period, from muskets and pistols to swords. And while the American revolution was mainly fought on land, there were notable sea battles, including when Privateers aided the primitive Colonial Navy with the help of the French. John Paul Jones emerged as a hero in the American Navy which, surprisingly, captured the British warship, *HMS Serapis*, during the Battle of Flamborough Head on September 23, 1779.

His famous quote during this battle was "I have not yet begun to fight." His ship, *Bon Homme Richard* was heavily damaged when the British commander of HMS Serapis asked him if he was ready to surrender his ship. Jones' comment became a rallying cry during this war and to modern times.

I'd recommend that you take a few minutes at the start of your visit and watch a brief and, in my opinion, an excellent auditorium film that notes the way the American Revolutionary War began and sets the scene for what you'll see in the museum galleries.

The American Revolution War Museum is located along the York River, a short distance from the Coleman Bridge and the town's main area.

This museum has a well-stocked gift shop featuring Revolutionary War memorabilia, including related books, engraved coffee mugs and the usual souvenir items one finds in attractions. And even has socks with patriot Patrick Henry's image printed on them along with his famous quote, "But as for me, give me liberty or give me death."



The Flag of the Continental Navy, also known as the Gadsden Flag, still is an attention-getter these days.



This display explains the Colonists' successful Battle of Great Bridge fought in Chesapeake, Virginia, on December 9, 1775. For more information and descriptive exhibits about this battle, which forced Lord Dunmore, the British governor of Virginia, and his troops to eventually leave Virginia, you may visit the Great Bridge Battlefield and Waterway Museum.)



Colonists used these weapons' counterparts during the Revolutionary War.



British loyalist F. Sanderson produced this still as part of his tin-and copper-making business, first in Pennsylvania and later in Maryland. After the Revolution he was condemned for treason and fined for his unpatriotic stand.



For those who prefer to park in the free-of-charge in Yorktown's waterfront garage, the community offers a free trolley ride that includes a stop at the American Revolution War Museum. During 2025, this trolley runs from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily, and from November 21 through December 21, on Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. There's also plenty of vehicle parking at the museum. This trolley also stops at Yorktown's Victory monument.

Plan to spend at least an hour touring the museum; Longer would be better.

Admission to this museum is as follows: General admission to the American Revolution Museum is \$18 for ages 13 and over and \$12 for ages 6 to 12. York County residents are admitted free of charge with related residence identification.
